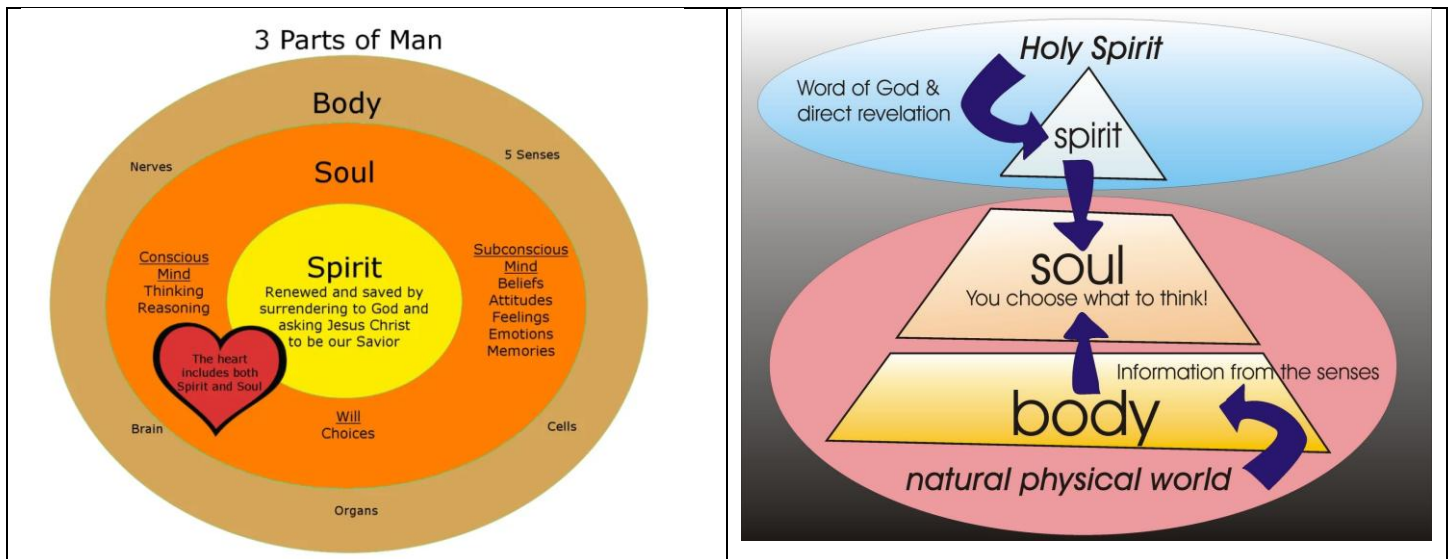

Its Yeast. Bakers add little yeast to the bread dough to make it very fluffy.

They leave the bread dough to rest for sometime, so that the yeast may be activated and fermentation happens. This is called leavening. If you bake the dough without giving it rest time, it’s called unleavened bread.
