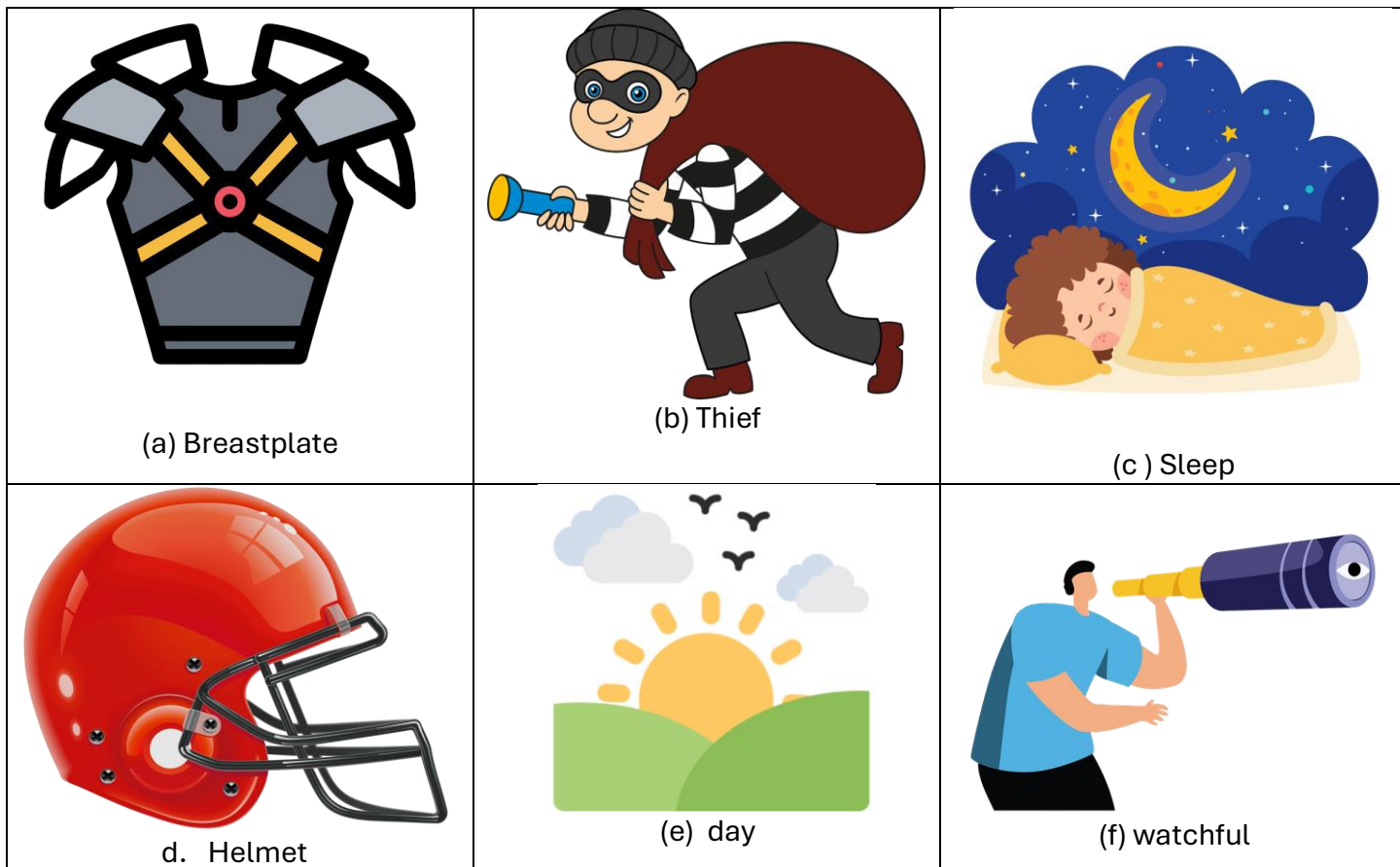

How can we be sober-

Remember the Hare and the tortoise story?

The Hare thought that still time is left and slept. But the tortoise even though its capability is limited, it kept on trying. So, to be sober or watchful is to be persevering, called to have self-control, clarity of thought, and moral discipline. To be "alert" or "vigilant" signifies maintaining a watchful spirit, fully aware of spiritual, emotional, and practical challenges.

It's not like in a week, 4 days I will be a good boy or girl- reading Bible, praying, obeying. And 3 days, I will disobey parents, I will skip Bible reading, I will be angry, speak bad words, will do what I like to do, watch cartoons, movies which is not fitting for God's Children. If we be like this- not consistent in doing good things- But rather do good and bad, then what will happen when Jesus comes during the days when you are bad?

Oh no- that means that he/she will not be eligible for God's Kingdom and will not be taken during second Coming
