Once a father who was a rich farmer called his sons Calen, Caleb, Carlo and gave three sacks of corn each. He mentioned that they need to live with this for the rest of the year. The three sons planned how they could survive with it.

First son Calen, planned to eat one corn per day and hence he can survive the whole year. Caleb went to the market and sold them and planned to use that money for the whole year.

Carlo went to the market and sold just one sack of corn. We ploughed the field and sowed one sack of corn. With the other sack, he used it for his daily meals.

Over the period of three months all three of them ran out of stock for food. But since Caleb had sown one sack of corn, he was able to harvest 100 sacks of fresh corn. He then sold few and was able to continue his living peacefully.

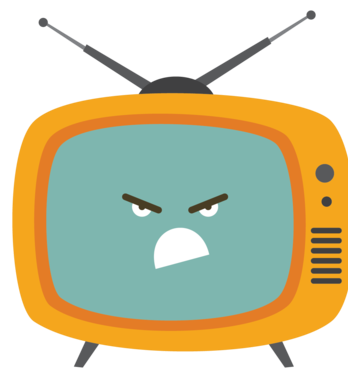
